RECIPE CORNER

Do you have a Recipe to share?

Fresh Apple Cake- Thank you to Joan Gosselin who shared this delicious recipe with us. Preheat oven 350 degrees. 13"x9"x2" pan

4 cups peeled apples 1 1/2 tsp baking soda 2 cups sugar 2 tsp cinnamon

2 cups flour 1 tsp salt

2 eggs 2 tsp vanilla extract

3/4 cup vegetable oil 1 cup chopped walnuts or

pecans



In large bowl stir together apples and sugar. Add dry ingredients, stir well. In small bowl, beat eggs, oil and vanilla. Stir into apple mixture blending until thoroughly moistened. Batter will be thick. Stir in nuts. Pour into 13"x9" pan. Bake 350 degrees for 50 minutes or until cake springs back when lightly pressed in center.

Serve warm or cool.

May be topped with powdered sugar, vanilla ice cream or apple dessert topping.
